



Preparing for an Exterior Insect Treatment

- If you are planning on cleaning or power-washing any structures, make sure that it is completed **BEFORE** we come to spray
- If you are planning on washing your windows, that should be completed **AFTER** we spray
- Make sure all windows are closed
- We cannot perform our treatment if you have other vendors/contractors working at the time of our service
- Things to move away from your house:
 - Pet food/water dishes
 - Pet beds/kennels
 - Pet toys
 - Shoes/boots
 - Grills
 - Bird feeders
 - Outdoor pillows or cushions on furniture
 - Children toys
 - Coolers
 - Any other items you would like to protect from the treatment
- Outdoor furniture is okay to stay where it is at
- Plants and flowers are okay to stay where they are at
 - If you have vegetable/herb plants under the eaves or close to your home you can cover them with a tarp or garbage bag (it will not harm the plant, but we would recommend washing the food before you eat it, if it is not covered)
- If possible, lift up your down spouts
- Pets should stay inside or away from the house for 2 hours, once it is dry they are safe to be back outside
- Cover bird baths with a tarp or garbage bag
- If you have fish in a pond nearby, they need to be covered, **and** we need to be notified
